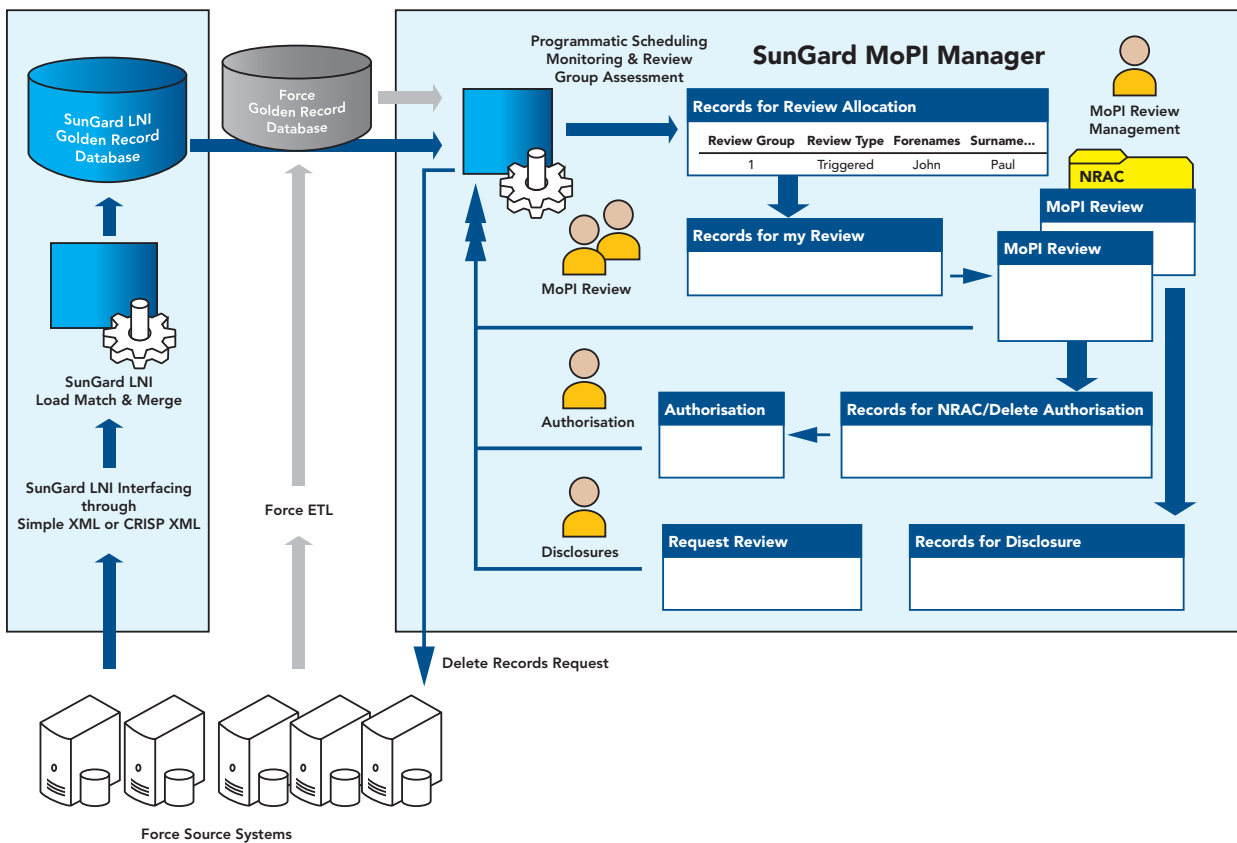

Built in asp.net, MoPI Manager is delivered as a web portal, with single sign on and role based access integrated into your force's directory service. All screens within MoPI Manager have been designed to be clear and logical, maximising ease of operator use. MoPI Manager and LNI products also comply with

the CorDM data standards. Business Service database access provides alignment with the Information System Strategy for the Police Service (ISS4PS), and means you will be equipped to share information with other forces as part of the overall alignment to the NPIA's IMPACT programme.

Review Allocation

Authorised managers accessing the record workload summary can assess and allocate review cases to team members, maximising productivity. MoPI Manager also highlights overdue cases to ensure that slippages are minimised.

Configurable Review And Retention

MoPI Manager can be tailored to meet the specific needs and operational rules of your force. Force specified risk group classification algorithms are built into the system, enabling cases to be reviewed and retained automatically or manually - maximising work flow rate and efficiency levels.

Quick And Accurate Decision Making

Each step of the review retention and disposal process, from initial review through to disclosure and disposal, is handled clearly and logically in MoPI Manager. Easy access to Linked Business Records gives the operator a full picture of the individual. NRAC forms disposal authorisation, and a "last chance to review" option prior to disposal, are also built into the system.

MoPI Manager audits all decisions within the management and review process giving reviewers a clear picture of all previous review decisions. In addition the system audits user activity and system activity to facilitate both security and performance audit.

Easy Emailing

Communicating with the participating systems is easy with MoPI Manager. Because the application is integrated to a force's mail server through SMTP, operators can email source system administrators directly.
